

King David

1. Each group draws one of the following five passages, each of which tells the story of a significant event or events in David's life:
 - 1 Samuel, chapter 16; and 1 Samuel 18:17–30 (David's anointing by Samuel, his calming effect on Saul, and his marriage to Michal)
 - 1 Samuel, chapter 17 (David's killing Goliath)
 - 1 Samuel 25:2–42 (David and Abigail)
 - 2 Samuel 6:1–7:17 (David's bringing the Ark of the Covenant to Jerusalem and the Davidic Covenant)
 - 2 Samuel 11:1–12:25 (David and Bathsheba)

2. Each group will randomly draw one of the following television show genres:
 - soap opera or *telenovela*
 - history channel biography / documentary
 - sitcom
 - Broadway show (drama or musical)
 - courtroom show
 - reality show
 - police drama
 - ESPN coverage of a sports event

3. Work with your group to create a "show" that focuses on the biblical passage your group drew in step 1 and that follows the conventions of the genre your group chose in step 2. Follow these guidelines in creating your show:
 - Your show should be about 5 minutes long.
 - Include the facts of what happens in your passage, but feel free to do that in a way that is engaging, entertaining, or even humorous.
 - Don't read your entire passage directly from the Bible, as this may **bore** your audience.
 - Don't change or update the story too much, as this may **confuse** your audience.
 - Costumes and props are optional, but encouraged.
