

The Collect, read by the presider, literally collects all our prayers together. A Collect is written to be read aloud.

- At the beginning of the Collect is a short explanation of the celebration or memorial.
- Then the assembly is invited to pray.
- Everyone prays in the silent pause that follows. That is why the pause must never be left out.
- The presider then "collects" these prayers together and prays aloud.
- · The Collect has a clear structure:

You: First we address God to whom we pray.

Do: Next we ask God, please, to do something for us.

Through: We make our prayer, "Through Christ our Lord." All respond, "Amen."

Look at the examples below, then write your own Collect for your school patron or a special saint. Read your collect aloud once you finish to see if it sounds the way you want it to.
