

WHEN DISASTER STRIKES, WE PRAY

LEADER: We gather today to pray for victims of natural disasters. I invite

each of you to recall a natural disaster you are familiar with. (pause) Imagine now all that people had to go through to recover, heal,

and rebuild their lives. (pause) Let us pray.

ALL: Dear Creator God,

Planet Earth, our common home, is so large, and yet so fragile.

When we glimpse the great needs of people impacted by the destructive forces of nature,

we can become overwhelmed.

We may even want to turn away,

but you call us back.

LEADER: Take several minutes to reflect on how you would complete the

sentence, "Inspire me to ..." What kinds of things could we pray for inspiration to do? Be prepared to share your prayer with the class.

Allow a moment of silence.

LEADER: As we go around the room, please share your prayer for inspiration.

Begin by saying, "Inspire me to ..." and complete the sentence with

your personal prayer. (Allow time for everyone to share.)

LEADER: And together, we close our prayer:

ALL: Help us encounter our sisters and brothers with open hearts.

Give us ears to listen to their stories.

Minds to learn and reflect. And wills determined to act.

Amen.
