
A mirror reflects the way you strike a pose, how you smile, frown, or make a silly face. A mirror shows you how you look the minute before you walk out the door into the world.

### Future

The people of Israel have a tradition of studying the Scriptures and of telling stories to help one another appreciate and understand the ways of God. Here is one of those stories:



When the people of Israel were called to receive the Torah from the Lord God, the Holy One, they stood at prayerful attention.

> But the Lord God responded, "No, the ancestors are not acceptable to me."

The people of Israel were startled and puzzled, but they tried again. They said: "We offer you our prophets. They will be loyal guarantors of your gift of the Torah."

Again the Lord God responded, "The prophets are unacceptable to me."

And again the people of Israel were startled. There followed a long silence. They looked at one another. They looked at their children, and suddenly they all understood. With one voice they said: "Behold, our children. They are our guarantors."

And the Lord God said, "Yes, they are acceptable to me. For their sake I give you the gift of Torah."

### A New Generation





