# INTRODUCTION

A concordance serves as an index for finding specific verses in the Bible. The *Saint Mary's Press*  $^{\text{TM}}$  *Essential Bible Concordance* lists key words in alphabetical order, followed by the Bible verses that contain the word. A complete concordance to the New American Bible would have over 300,000 entries covering 18,000 key words and would be fifty times the size of this present concordance! The *Saint Mary's Press Essential Bible Concordance*, selective and of a more manageable size, includes 650 key words that are most significant for personal Bible study.

Consider these suggestions for using the SAINT MARY'S PRESS Essential Bible Concordance:

- If you recall a key word from the Scripture passage or Bible story that you wish to locate, look up this key word in the concordance. If the concordance lists the word, you will see one or more verse references to help you locate the passage or the story.
- By looking up all the verse references for a particular key word, you can learn about the different ways the Bible uses the word and the various stories in which the word appears.
- You can use the concordance to find an appropriate Scripture reading for a prayer service. By looking up key words related to the theme of your prayer service, you can locate relevant verses and select the Scripture passages.

If you cannot find a particular key word, the one you are looking for might occur in a different translation of the Bible or might not be included in the SAINT MARY'S PRESS Essential Bible Concordance.

# **Understanding the Concordance Entries**

The following example is a typical entry from the SAINT MARY'S PRESS Essential Bible Concordance:

#### ABOUND (ED) (ING)

Each concordance entry lists the key word in boldface, followed by any alternative endings (in parentheses) that are also indexed. One or more context lines below the key word include the reference (book, chapter, and verse) and a short excerpt to indicate the context of the key word, which is represented by its initial letter in boldface. The abbreviations of the books of the Bible are listed on page 4.
