

# What Is Prayer?

## Session Summary

- Responding to the sacred with faith involves trust in God and courage to accept all the circumstances of life.
- Prayer is the raising of one's mind and heart to God. It is a reciprocal call—a call to relationship—between God and human beings. It is an awareness of and a response to God's presence.
- The Holy Spirit teaches the Church to pray. The Scriptures; the liturgy; the virtues of faith, hope, and charity; and different schools of Christian spirituality are all sources of prayer.
- According to the Scriptures, it is the heart that prays. It is where a person's covenant relationship with God unfolds. Because God blesses the human heart, we in turn bless God who is the source of every blessing.
- Prayer is different from “prayers.” Prayer is an attitude. Saying prayers is an activity. The right attitude transforms activities into true prayer.

## Talk Points

- Make a top-ten list of the reasons why prayer is essential in your life.
- Discuss the most powerful prayer experience you have ever had.
- Name all the different ways you and your family or friends have prayed together.
- Consider designating a certain time each day or each week to gather together and try out a new type or style of prayer.
